Specific Responsibilities:

9. Assist in the proper care, usage, storage, and maintenance of camp equipment.
10. Participate in all camp wide activities.
11. Assist in the set-up and takedown of all camp facilities.
12. Assist area directors in submission of advancement records due at the end of the week.
13. All other duties as assigned.
