

Lifeguards

Reports To: Aquatics Director

Objective: To instruct campers in various aquatics activities and perform lifeguard duties.

Essential Functions: Must be at least 16 years old and possess or be able to obtain a valid Red Cross Lifeguard certification. Must be physically able to conduct rescue type maneuvers, able to see and act quickly in emergencies, and communicate clearly.

Specific Responsibilities: Specific responsibilities are:

1. Instruct activities in which they are proficient.
2. Be familiar with and assist in the enforcement of all safety rules and policies for waterfront areas.
3. Maintain strict safety discipline at all times when campers, leaders, and other staff are in the waterfront area.
4. Assist in the proper care, usage, storage, and maintenance of all aquatics equipment.
5. Participate in any aquatic programs as directed.
6. Participate in camp wide activities.
7. Assist in the set-up and takedown of all waterfront areas and other campsite facilities.
8. All other duties as assigned.
